Dunbar

Utilising the same technology as proposed at Overwood, Dunbar ERF treats up to 325,000 tonnes of waste per annum. Lying close to the East Lothian coastline, the ERF is located adjacent to an active landfill and sits between two designated Special Landscape Areas.

The ERF delivers a robust package of community benefits focused on employment and training, support for local business and education through our flagship partnership with the Engineering Development Trust¹. Now in operation, the ERF supports 56 full-time jobs, including a range of professional, skilled jobs together with entry-level roles and apprenticeships, significantly boosting the East Lothian economy each year.

The construction phase involved expenditure of circa £17m in the Lothian area and a further £23m throughout Scotland.
