



An extensive pre-application consultation and EIA Scoping exercise is in progress with South Lanarkshire Council to agree the scope and approach of technical studies to support the planning application.

Before we submit a planning application, we need to understand what the potential impacts of the facility will be. We will be carrying out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). The EIA will assess the potential impacts on:

- Air Quality and Odour
- Ecology
- Surface Water and Flood Risk
- Archaeology and Cultural Heritage
- Landscape and Visual
- Traffic and Transport
- Climate Change
- Noise

Many of these studies and assessments are currently being undertaken by a team of specialist consultants. A summary of the assessments will be provided at the second virtual exhibition scheduled to commence on 1st April 2021.

The assessments, impacts and mitigation measures (including technical reports) will be incorporated in the EIA that will be submitted with the planning application.
