



## Construction Environmental Management Plan

During the construction phase, site activities would be managed by a Construction Environmental Management Plan (CEMP) that would be developed in conjunction with the site contractor and agreed upon with South Lanarkshire Council.

The CEMP will be designed to outline how Viridor, and its contractors, will avoid, minimise and mitigate effects on the local environment, surrounding area and community during the 3-year construction programme.

The scope of the CEMP will encompass a wide range of environmental disciplines, many of which we have been identified as part of the technical assessments. This includes construction impacts on air quality, noise, ground conditions and site drainage.

It is anticipated that the following measures would be implemented in line with common site practices (but not limited to):

- Establishment of a Community Liaison Group to allow residents to contact the site manager with any concerns
- Develop and implement a Dust and Noise Management Plan
- Record all enquiries and concerns, identify cause(s), take appropriate measures and record any actions taken
- Construction to occur only within approved working hours
- Enforcement of the traffic routing agreement during the construction programme

## Community Liaison Group

As part of Viridor's dedication to keeping the community up-to-date with activities at the facility, we will operate a local community liaison group at Overwood ERF. This group will include representatives from the local community, South Lanarkshire Council, local politicians, SEPA and site management.

The requirement to manage and coordinate this Group, in perpetuity, will be secured as part of the planning application.
